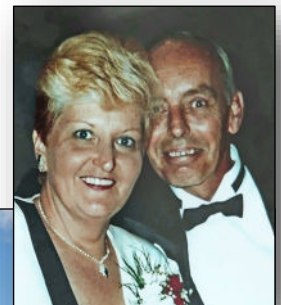
Editor's Remembrance: Donna Damon

May 29 Cruise Winner 1952 Chevrolet BelAir Restomod

Wally Hayes, leader of the Old Koots Car Club out of Norwood, is well known for owning some very nice and interesting cars and, with many of them taking home deserving Vintage Motorsports Cruise award plaques over the years. His 1952 Chevrolet BelAir resto-rod is no exception and has the unique honor of garnering its second. Fortunately, the first one was back in 2022 which lets it slip back into the spotlight using our three-year rule which limits repeat selections. Wally has owned the Chevy for four years now, adding only 4,200 miles to the 1,000 miles since the original build. He comments that this is still one of the nicest cars he has owned and despite only driving it mostly to local shows, exception being the Syracuse Nationals in 2023, he'd drive it anywhere because it rides beautifully. It was built by the former Kentucky owner, originally for himself, from a car that had been in storage since 1969. It was built over 14 months straight, full time, only farming out the PPG Gulf Blue & Fontana Grey two-tone paint and matching grey leather custom interior and upholstery work to Pro Custom Interiors in Knoxville, TN. The resto-mod was executed perfectly hiding a former 2008 Silverado LS1 V8 under the hood and with a 4L60E four-speed overdrive tranny, Wally was able to average 23.6 mpg when he drove it to the Syracuse Nationals and back, this means it doesn't need to become a trailer queen for those long-distance rides. The Mustang II front end, 15" Ridler Wheels, radials, P.S. & P.B. makes handling on the highway a breeze.



Other than those telltale Ridler highly polished chrome wheels, it isn't until you open the door and look inside Wally's Chevy that this is not an original, but one spectacular Restomod with all the creature comforts necessary for cross —country road touring.

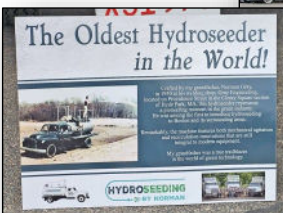

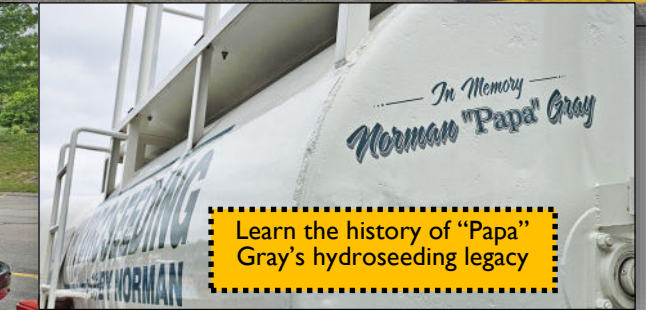

Local Plainville resident John Hurley has a blue Pontiac Firebird and a friend of his, who once owned a 1968 red Firebird convertible with white leather interior, asked him four years ago if he came across one for sale to let him know because he would like to buy it. John found one at a local cruise night for sale that, although it was modestly hot rodded, was in perfect condition, so he called his friend telling him that he had found what he was looking for. His friend looked it over, loved the car, but his wife ultimately nixed the deal. John's wife loved the car, so he bought it. Three weeks later his friend came back and said he can now buy the car. John said no, my wife loves the car, I can't sell it, even turning down a doubling offer of the purchased price. So, here it is, with its non-original flame-red paint and original red interior replaced with ivory leather upholstery garnering the Vintage Motorsports Cruise Award. The original 400 HP V8 is backed up with a non-original Tremec five-speed tranny which greatly improved its performance and fuel economy. We have not seen the Firebird that often at our cruises because John also has a number of cars and he actively participates at our cruise nights by organizing both the August featured Lady's Night cruise-in and the September Bass Pro Shops Cruise featured Tri-5 Chevy Club's cruise-in. Our June 12 Bass Pro Shops Cruise at Patriot Place in Foxborough finally enjoyed some perfect weather. And, with over 1,200 show cars counted coming through the front entrance where collections for St. Anthony's Free Market food pantry in Stoughton was taking place. Patriot Place implemented their new 2025 traffic control policy by shutting down entry to the main cruise Lots 14 & 16, and redirecting the show car traffic to the overflow parking Lot 20 B in front of the Renaissance Hotel for the first time this year. The good news, however, for later arriving cruise attendees was that access to the main cruise lots was re-opened later on when a substantial number of early leaving show cars allowed for the usual heavy spectator foot traffic in the main lots that our cruises typically experience during these perfect weather conditions allowed for safe driving and parking again through the show lot travel lanes.

June 8 Bay State Motor Festival

We had a dozen club member show cars attend and display around a Maple tree in the Cushing Memorial Park in Framingham for Ken Lemoine's Bay State Motor Festival that was celebrating 100 years of Massachusetts Car Manufacturing in conjunction the city of Framingham's 325th Anniversary. Most did not realize that early American automotive manufacturing began in Massachusetts in 1893 and not Detroit, and that over 7 million automobiles were produced in Massachusetts. Festival organizer Ken Lemoine was able to persuade owners of many of these early marques to take part in celebrating these Massachusetts based American automotive pioneers. The beautiful and spacious Cushing Memorial Park setting in Framingham, which is a just a stone's throw from the still-standing building used to produce Framingham's Bay State automobiles, is the perfect venue to showcase these historic vehicles. Ken is also the owner of a just-completed and restored sole-surviving 1924 Bay State Sedan just in time for the Festival.

But, were we really aware there was also a Grout Steam car built in Orange, MA, or Marsh Light Cars and Motorcycles built in Brockton or the Watertown transplanted to Bridgeport, CT manufactured "Best of Show" 1917 Model 48 Dual Cowl Sportif Locomobile having its custom body built by Brookline builders Farnum & Nelson for Liggett-"Rexall" Drug magnet Louis Liggett? There was so much automotive history to take in, I was happy to learn that Ken has secured permission by the town of Framingham to repeat this show on June 7, 2026 which will definitely be a must-attend event for our club.
